Canaccord Genuity Voted Wealth Management Company of the Year

Winners of the City of London Wealth Management Awards have been announced at The Guildhall. Canaccord Genuity won the Award for Wealth Management Company of the Year while Martin Waller of The Times won the Financial Journalist of the Year Award for his thorough research in the Tempus column throughout last year.

Paul Killik, whose firm celebrated its 25th anniversary earlier this year, won a Lifetime Achievement Award, presented by Brian Winterflood MBE.
